APPENDIX “E” – FISHING RULES & REGULATIONS SUMMARY

With a constantly changing membership we have found that some members do not understand or comply with our Rules and Regulations. The Club Rules serve to protect our great fishery, and are designed to be as fair as possible to all members. Our annual stocking program is expensive and all members must follow strict catch limits. It is every member’s responsibility and duty to comply with the Rules and help enforce them. Any infractions should be reported to a member of the Executive; please name the offending party. Failure to comply with Club Rules and Regulations can lead to disciplinary action, up to and including termination of membership.

Fish Limits & Rules

- Family Membership:** Limit 4 Trout in 1 day with no angler catching more than 2 Trout
- Single Membership:** Limit 2 Trout in 1 day.
- Senior Citizen Membership:** Limit 4 Trout in 1 day with no angler catching more than 2 Trout
- Youth/Sponsored Youth Membership:** Limit 2 Trout in 1 day which are counted as part of the Family limit of 4
- Sponsored Child:** Limit 2 Trout in 1 day which are counted as part of the Sponsor’s limit

Other

- ** Membership cards MUST BE VISIBLY WORN while on the property while fishing and should be worn while on the property.
- ** No One may angle for someone else. Only 1 fishing line per angler and it must be attended.
- ** Any Angler catching 2 Trout MUST cease fishing for the Day. All Trout caught must be registered as part of that angler’s daily limit (even if you give the fish away)).
- ** No Trout may be returned to the Pond after it has been caught.
- ** All Bass must be returned to the pond with the least possible harm to the fish.
- ** Bass must not be intentionally targeted until the official season opening.
- ** NO MINNOWS (Dead, Preserved or Alive) and NO CORN are to be used as bait
- ** ALL children under 16 must be accompanied and supervised by an Adult Card Holder
- ** A Guest is limited to twice per year per membership.

Appendix E – Fishing Rules and Regulations Summary (Page 2)

DEAR MEMBERS – PLEASE NOTE AND COMPLY

General

- 1) Keep docks clear at all times.
- 2) Personal property, except boats in the boat rack, may NOT be left at the Club.
- 3) Children must be with an adult at all times, on the docks and near the water.
- 4) No horseplay on the docks or around the water.
- 5) Sunfish may be returned to the lake.
- 6) Report all non-members poaching on the lake to the Club custodians.
- 7) Report any damage you may find on the property to the Executive or Club custodians.
- 8) All Trout caught must be kept. DO NOT put them back in the lake.
- 9) Fishing hours are from dawn till dusk, every day.
- 10) No alcoholic beverages allowed on the lake or grounds.
- 11) The most important rule of all is to Be Safe And Have Fun.
- 12) Failure to comply with Rules and Regulations could result in the cancellation of your membership.

... ADDITIONAL WINTER FISHING RULES.

- 1) Place all garbage (i.e. cigarette butts, fishing line, coffee cups, pop cans, etc.) found on the ice in the barrels provided on the shore.
- 2) Holes that are cut in the ice **MUST BE MARKED** with a branch or an evergreen limb.
- 3) Do not cut ice fishing holes within 100 ft. of the skating rink area.
- 4) You may use 2 rods OR 2 hooks on 1 line per person at any time during the ice fishing season only.
- 5) All children on the ice must be with an adult at all times.
- 6) When making an ice rink, only clear off what you are going to be using.
- 7) Ice conditions are posted, **USE ICE AT YOUR OWN RISK.**

... ADDITIONAL SUMMER FISHING RULES.

- 1) Place all garbage (i.e. cigarette butts, fishing line, coffee cups, pop cans, etc.) in the barrels provided on the shore.
- 2) The back dock is for launching boats. More than eight (8) people on the dock is unsafe.
- 3) Boaters have priority over the back dock, BUT boaters must show common courtesy to other fisherman.
- 4) All boats on Club racks must be registered.
- 5) No tying boats to the dock for more than 15 minutes and keep out of the way of others.
- 6) There is no fishing from the unmaintained shoreline due to sinkholes. Fishing is permitted from the docks and their immediate areas or from boats/float tubes.
- 7) Park vehicles at least 20 feet away from the boat racks so as not to block other members' access to their boats.
