




Members at our January meeting were treated to an informative and interesting presentation on Walleye by Felix Barbetti.

I just got home from speaking to Bert Cronkwright's Hunter Ed. class this morning in Waterford. I've been helping Bert with the enforcement section of the course for several years, and after retiring from a Conservation Officer, Bert still asks me to attend. It is always a pleasure to do this for him, and I really appreciate the chance to speak with new hunters. It has been my hope and still remains today that these students take an active role in hunting. I make sure to remind them that nothing brings you closer to respecting and appreciating our natural resources than being out there, whether you pull a trigger or not.

This winter has been anything but. Little snowfall on the land and little or no ice on our lakes really put a crimp in plans for winter hunting and ice fishing enthusiasts. The coyote and fox hunters however are still taking opportunities when they can and have been rewarded with the harvest of healthy animals. Little or no mange is being observed.

Coyote numbers are still good in my area of Norfolk County, but early fall plowing in Elgin County may have impacted numbers there as anecdotal evidence suggests coyote populations have either been reduced or moved to other locations. The deer populations also were impacted, with hunters reporting fewer deer seen.

On the flip side, reports of bald eagle sightings are clearly showing remarkable increases. Two of our members that attended the January OFAH Zone J meeting in London reported seeing upwards of 30 eagles near Delaware, west of London after the meeting. Long Point also saw several with a local resident photographing 14 in one tree this winter.

Our OFAH Zone J executive will have a different appearance after the April 1st meeting and elections. Tony Jackson was recently acclaimed as director at large, and will step away from the Zone Chairs position in March. As 1st vice chair I will sit in the chairs position in an acting role until Zone elections are held April 1st.

This is a great opportunity for other members in our Zone to think about running for the executive. All positions are open, and with over 23,000 members in this Zone, I am hoping to see some interested folks submit their names for election.
