Be sure to include information on the exact location of the violation, date and time of the violation, and a description of the individuals and vehicles involved. Timely and accurate information will assist conservation officers in apprehending violators and protect your natural resources. The OFAHencourages you to report anything suspicious to the MNRTips line. The information you have may just be the important piece needed to stop the abuse. Our MNR Gonservation Officers cannot be everywhere all of the time. Flease help them protect our natural resources.
