
Heartfelt sympathies are extended to the Noftle family after the passing of Guy Noftle after a lengthy illness.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO FISHERMEN

The Fall Trout Derby will be held on Sunday, October 17th. Watch your newsletter and the Bulltein Board for more details.

Please remember to record your catch in the Fish Log Book located just inside the side entrance. The Fishing rules are posted as a reminder of the catch limits allotted to each membership type. Culling is not allowed.

Trout can not be introduced into the water until the water temperature cools significantly to at least 58°F. Stocking can then occur without stressing and killing the Trout. Stocking often happens without much notice (and doesn't make it into the monthly newsletter) due to the water temperature and delivery availability. Watch the bulletin boards at the club for details as the weather cools.
